## "THE SOURCES OF ABSTRACT ART AND OF MODERN ARCHITECTURE IN HOLLAND " Report of J. J. Sweeney:

Backgroung of romantic architecture and romantic painting in Holland : exaggereted emphasis on associational, extra-structural interests - expressionistic, historical, sentimental.

Corrective value of Doesberg's stress on rational, scientific approach .

The Stijl movement's contribution towards the development of contemporary architecture, out of pictorial analyses of forms and through the structural use of color.

Danger involved: impoverishment of imaginative factor through the stripping away of features extraneous to structure and limitation to reasoned ("calculated") effecte.

Mondrian's importance: constant awareness of importance of sensibility in a woork of art and for extra - structural associations: for exemple his metaphysical "content". Realisation of danger to his outlook in Doesberg's influence. Constant effort to maintain freedom of sensibility with in the structural framework as explained in late letters.
