

Report on Archives - American Section

During the year 1955-1956 the American Section of the A.I.S.A. continued its work towards the compilation of an archive of ~~the~~ ^{the} Dada movement in the United States and its relationships to European Dada.

Dr Louise Averill Joendsen and Miss Jeanne Unger of the staff of the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum in New York made a special study of the Arnsberg Collection materials in Philadelphia, the Katherine Speir Collection at Yale University in New Haven and began work on the Arthur Jerome Eddy Collection materials in Chicago.

The sources of personal items, letters, catalogues, fugitive publications of the period were being sought for exploration.

A plan to publish the results in conformity with the volumes planned by the Italian Section was undertaken.
